

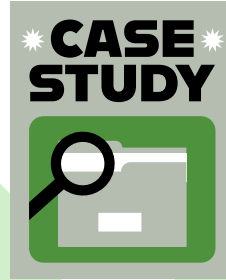
# Food Community Project Focus Areas
