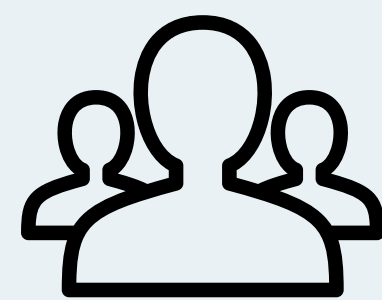

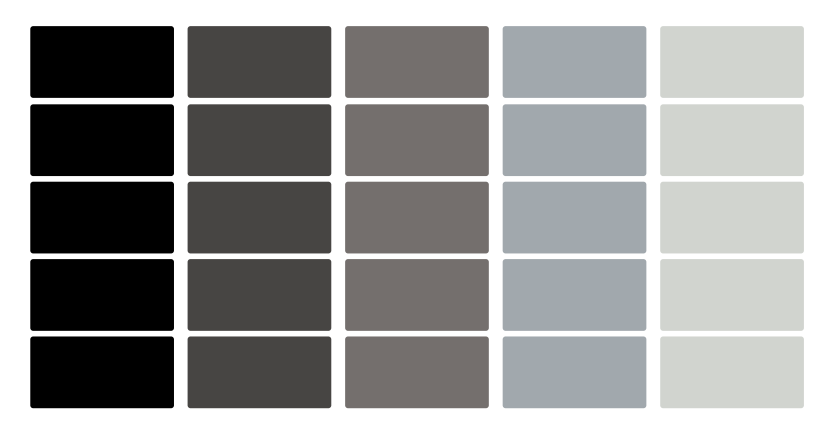

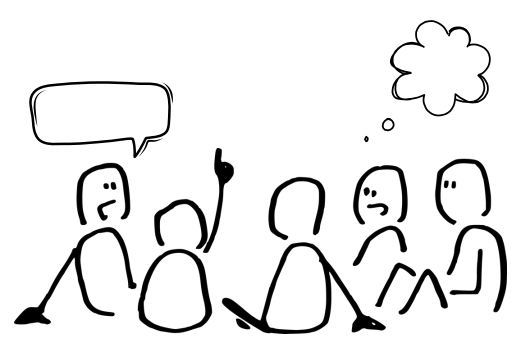
28 initiative interviews explored 30 initiatives

Government and community initiative staff/volunteers participated in an interview, to understand how their work contributed to systems change. It's all about facilitating a transition to a more effective way of supporting food security, across the whole system of initiatives.



Systems Change Map

A map was created to show how the initiatives contributed to systems change, across nine Focus Areas. The map was used to identify key Focus Areas, and 'windows of opportunity' to strengthen with people running food security initiatives.



Action Planning Workshop

Participants were invited to a results-sharing and action planning workshop in June 2023. During the workshop, interviewed participants co-designed individual action plans for their initiatives, with the Food Community team. Participants were supported to identify actions they could undertake to strengthen their initiative's contribution to food security in the Great Southern region. Participants also brainstormed potential new food security initiatives to fill service provision gaps in the current system.



Results

30 initiatives explored in interviews
77 partnering organisations

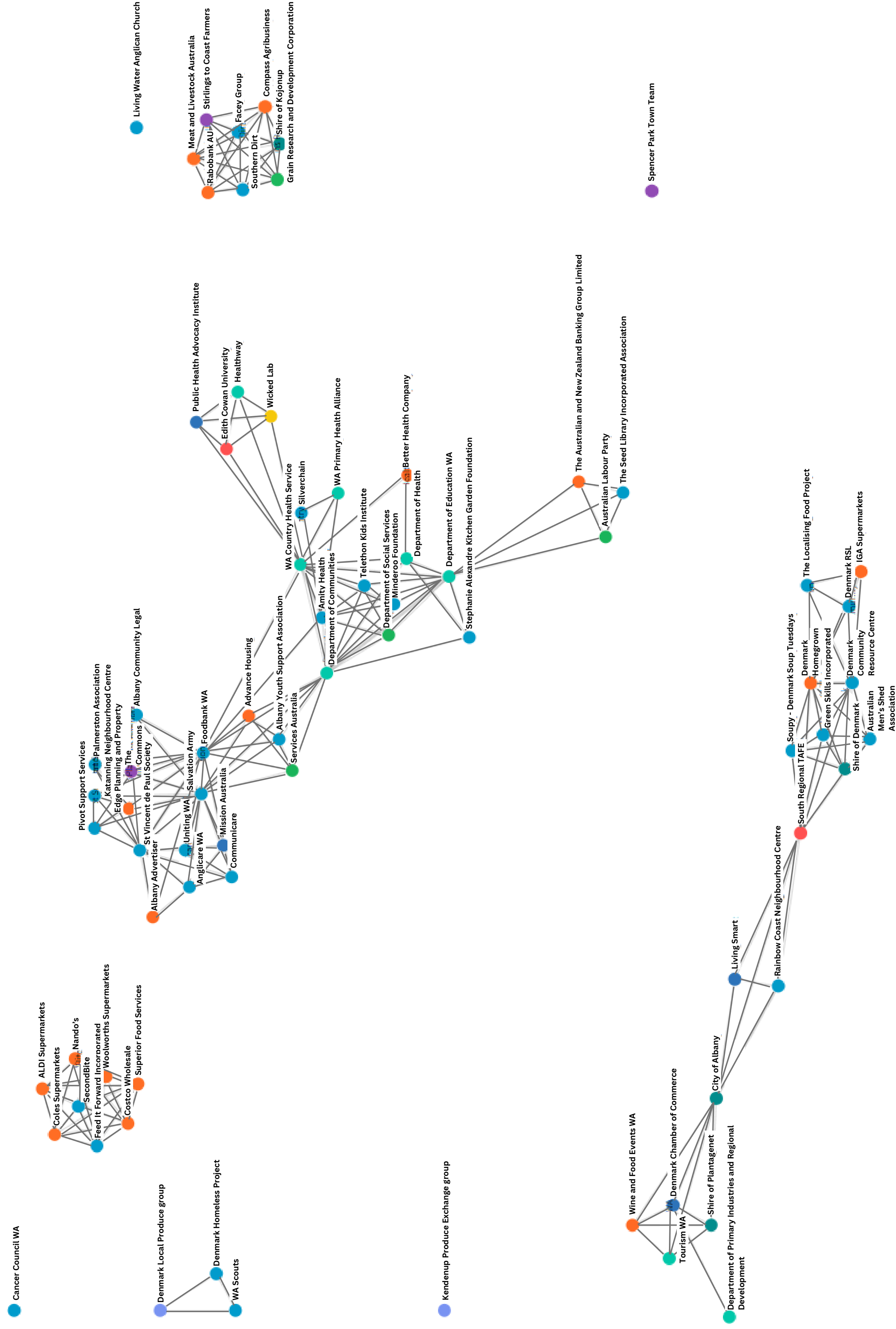

Initiative food security aspects:

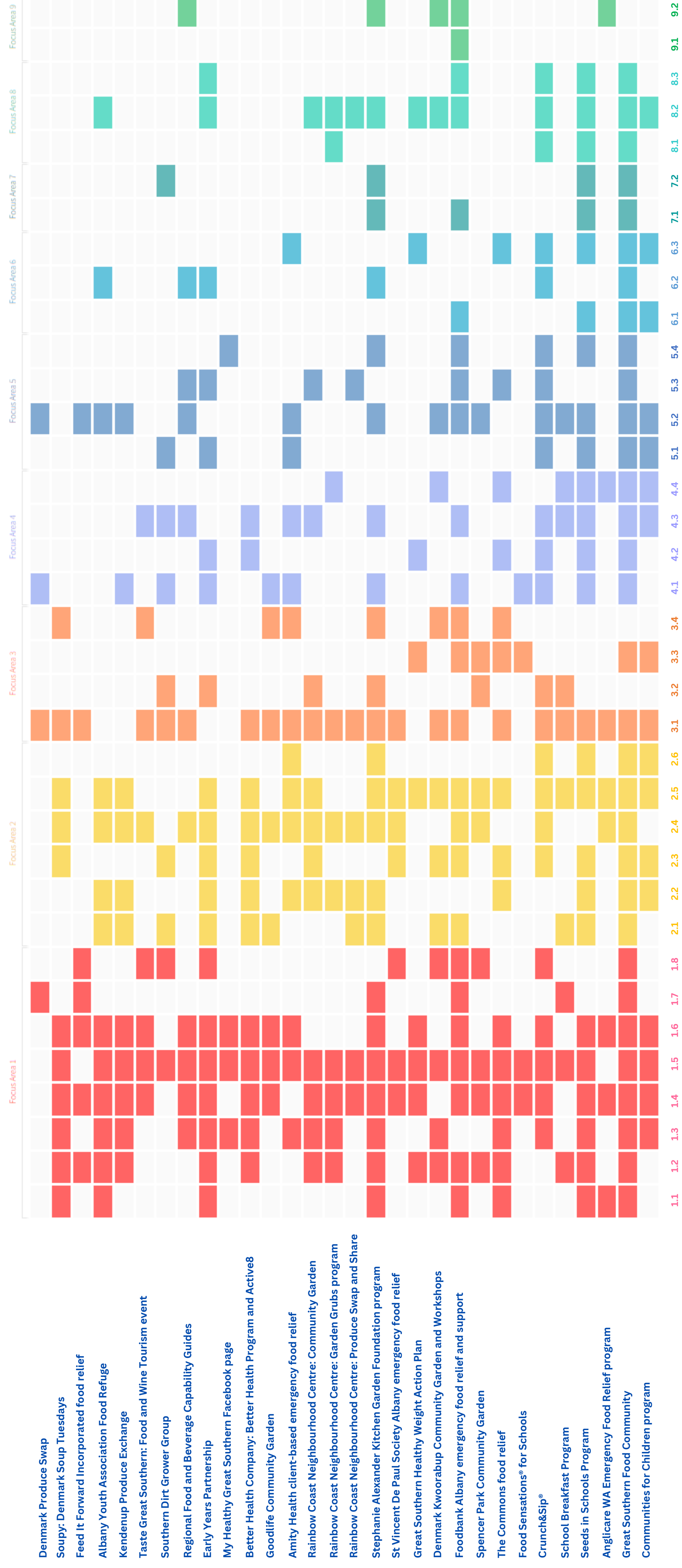
- 11x** food availability

The partnership map outlines the relationships that are currently established between initiatives and other organisations. This could include partnerships, sponsors or key stakeholders.

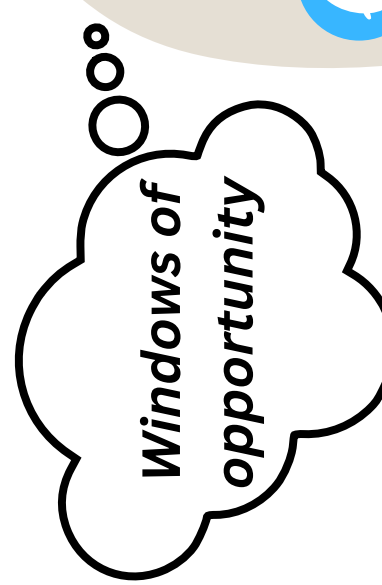


Systems Change Map



Focus Areas to strengthen:

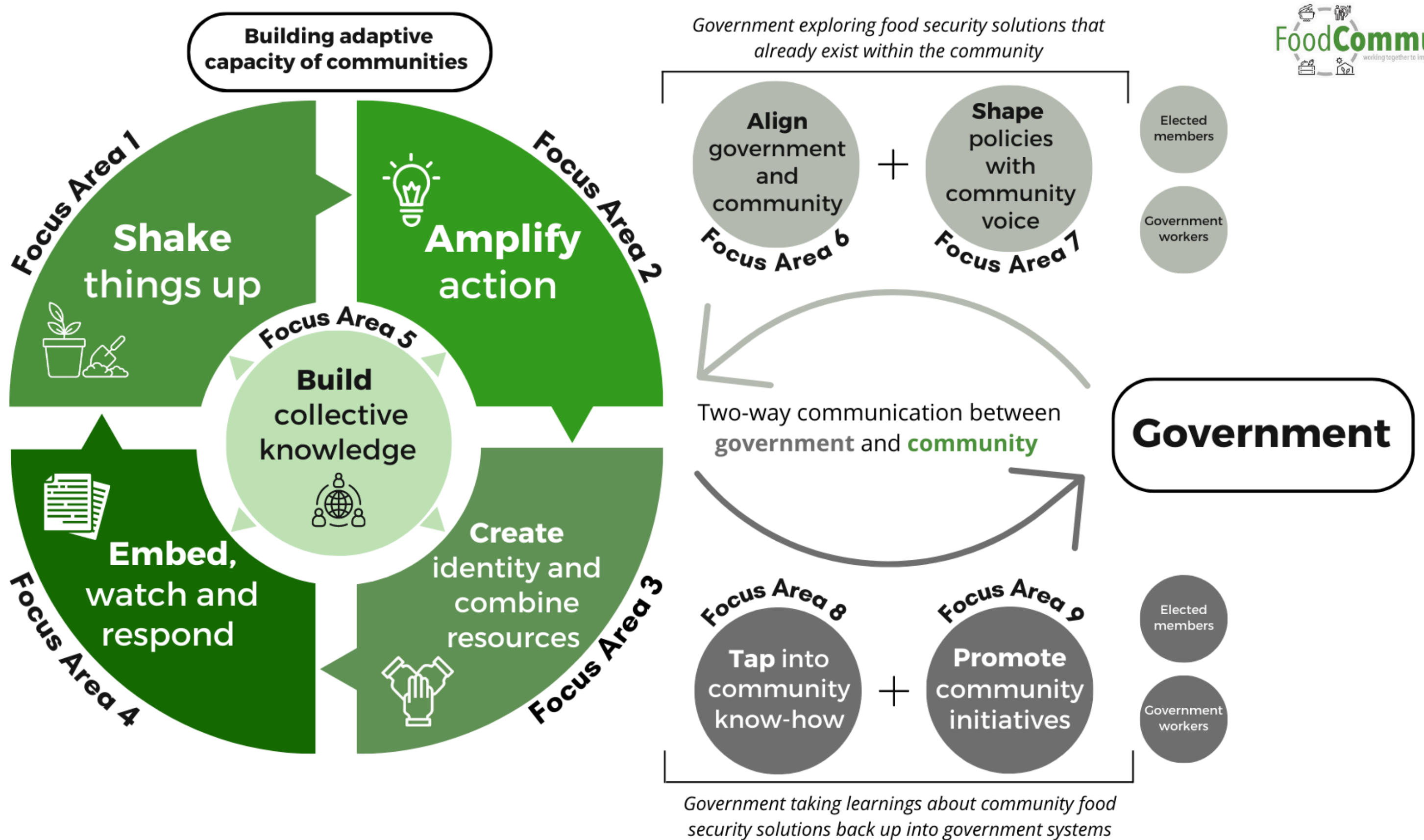
